Students in the Senior Room will be starting to complete their eSmart Digital License over the coming weeks. Students will receive a certificate at the completion of these 8 modules.

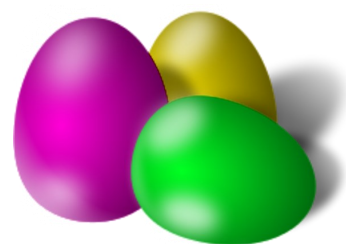
What is the eSmart Digital License?
