We will be having our next meeting on Wednesday 26th July commencing at 7pm. All Councillors are urged to attend.

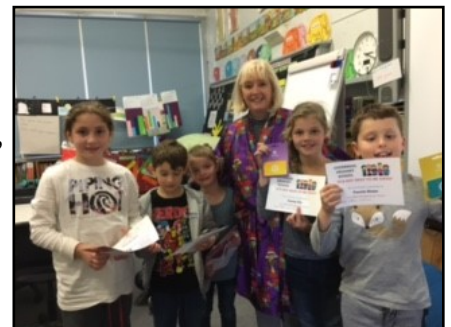
Thank You!!!
