## Digestive System

Some reflections -

*Caleb—I learned that the food that we eat goes down the oesophagus into 3 to 4 seconds. The stomach turns it into liquid. The liquid goes to the small intestine and the good stuff goes to the liver and the bad stuff to the colon. The food can stay there for 4 hours to get harder and it come out of the rectum.*

*Kasey—When we eat our food it gets broken down and is used as energy by our bodies. This is called the digestive system. If you eat an apple it gives you energy to get fit.*

*Samuel—I learnt that the saliva in your mouth is to make our food mushy so we can swallow it. It was fun to make a body with the digestive system.
