Rationale:

Aims:

Implementation:

- Our school requires that all staff members adopt a team approach.
- All staff members will undergo professional development in relation to high performing teams, including personality profiling, team effectiveness, performance feedback, goal setting and strategic planning.
- All staff members will be involved in team building exercises and programs.

Evaluation:

- This policy will be reviewed annually by team leaders in consultation with the principal class team as part of the school's regular review cycle.
