## Student Scholarships

Students in Years 4 –11 may be eligible for a scholarship which could range from \$300—\$1000. Students must be enrolled in a Victorian School and must be an Australian citizens to be eligible. Scholarships have eligibility requirements such as, financial need (a valid Centrelink reference number), while others have very specific criteria, such as membership with Vic Police or the Rail, Tram and Bus Union.
