***Staffing This Week***

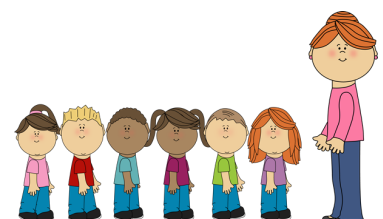
