will be used to support Cassidy with education costs or equipment. A certificate of congratulations was also presented. Mrs Price passed away in December 2009, and the award was presented in her memory, by Doris' daughter Sandra Jardine.



As a member of the Mildura Deaf Auxiliary for 40 years, Mrs Price voluntarily raised money for the Victorian School for Deaf Children in Melbourne, and also for hearing impaired students in Mildura and surrounding areas. The members assisted students and their families by providing educational and other supports. During that time, members presented a scholarship each year to a local hearing challenged child, to assist with their education. After her passing, Mrs Price's family decided to re-establish this tradition.

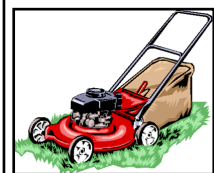
