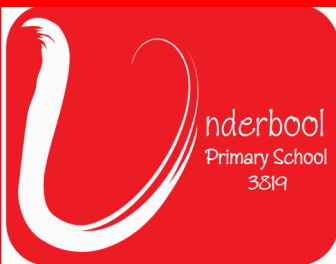

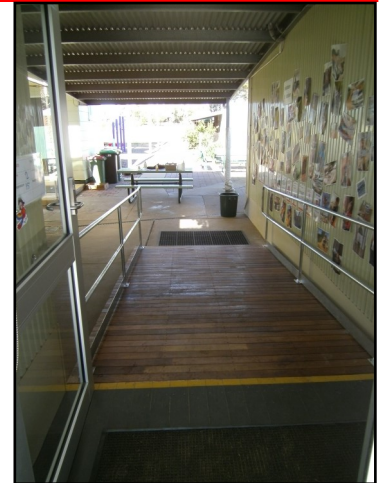

### Grade 6 Transition - Ouyen P-12

We wish all Students in Grade 6 the best of luck with their first day of transition tomorrow. Some notes on what you need and where to be are provided below.

- School Bus Travel—Underbool students have 3 options—they will need to be at the bus stop in Mossop Street, at the Hall bus stop or be at the bus in Fasham Street at 7.45am. If there is a Wednesday that you child will not be attending the transition program please text this info to Robert Gloster on 0429 946291
- Walpeup students will need to be at the bus stop beside the Walpeup Hall by 7.40am.
- Students are to wear their Underbool Primary School Uniform during transition.
- Pack your water bottle and lunch/snacks.
- School hats, pencil cases & books & reader folders will be organised at UPS and students will take these home each **Tuesday night for Wednesday transition and be required to bring them back on Thursday to UPS.**
- We will notify parents if there are any special requests from the school.
- Students with Asthma plans/Anaphylaxis will also take their medication home with them each Tuesday night and return to school Thursday morning.
- Students will need to pack a change of clothes and shoes as they will be doing Ag.
- Mrs Pryse will greet the students on arrival tomorrow morning.

These plans will be shared with Ouyen P-12 staff for the safety of students during transition.
