Starting at the playground, students will have the option to complete one of the following:

- Complete one and a half laps of the lake (3km).

Students will be asked to select their preferred option during Week 1 of Term 2. They are to be timed in order to consider their ability to compete at Sunraysia South in Mildura on Wednesday the 5<sup>th</sup> of May.

We will depart the school at 11:00am and meet Tempy Primary School at the lake. Students will eat their lunch after completing the run and have time to play with the Tempy students. Students will return to school prior to departure time.

Students will receive permission forms and further information at the beginning of Week 1, Term 2. Parents are welcome to attend

and volunteer on the day to provide support to students around the lake.
