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## Sport Report

### Loop around the Ouyen Lake - Underbool Primary School and Tempy Primary School

In preparation for Cross Country this term, students **aged 9 to 12 years** will be running a lap of the Ouyen Lake this Friday.

Date: **FRIDAY THE 23<sup>RD</sup> OF APRIL**

Time: **11:30am**

What to Bring: **comfortable running shoes, hat, lunch and a water bottle.**

Starting at the playground, students will have the option to complete one of the following:

- One lap of the lake (2km) OR
- Complete one and a half laps of the lake (3km).

Students will be asked to select their preferred option before Friday. They are to be timed in order to consider their ability to compete at Sunraysia South in Mildura on Wednesday the 5<sup>th</sup> of May.

We will depart the school at 11:00am and meet Tempy Primary School at the lake. Students will eat their lunch after completing the run and have time to play with the Tempy students. Students will return to school prior to departure time.
