Welcome to Week 6, it is incredible how quickly the term is disappearing. For most families this time of year just gets busier and busier. Take extra care of yourselves and your families, particularly when out on the roads, as there will be a lot of extra machinery on the move.

2022 VICTORIAN JUNIOR LANDCARE & BIODIVERSITY GRANT

Underbool Primary School is one of 110 schools and youth organisations to receive a 2022 Victorian Junior Landcare and Biodiversity Grant.

The grants are funded by the Victorian Government through the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning. Delivered through Landcare Australia's Junior Landcare program, the grants provide young people with the opportunity to engage in outdoor, hands-on biodiversity focused projects or learning activities that provide both environmental and educational outcomes, as well as health and social benefits.

We will be receiving \$2,793.60, and this will contribute towards the cost of an incursion by EnviroEDU's Sarah Holmes. Sarah is an ecologist who presents fun, interactive 'hands on' environmental education and conservation-based programs tailored to suit various age groups. She provides native wildlife encounters and sustainability incursions. We are still aiming to achieve our trip to Pink Lakes, to participate in activities that foster an awareness, appreciation and understanding of the natural environment and cultural values of parks. Students will also have an opportunity to learn about the biodiversity and threatened species living in the local area. One of our major goals is to assist in establishing wildlife corridors for threatened species by planting, guarding, and watering in 200 trees in a degraded Parks Victoria Reserve outside Underbool.

Our thanks and appreciation are extended to *Marissa Shean*, *South East Mallee Landcare Facilitator* for working on and fully supporting our application. Marissa's expertise and knowledge in this area was a great advantage. Our project must be completed, and a final report submitted by August 2023.


